Language Requirements	<p>General recommendations B1 level of Spanish/Catalan/English is recommended to attend subjects taught in these languages.</p> <p>Specific requirements</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - A B1 level of Spanish is mandatory to attend the Bachelor's Degrees of Tourism and Hotel Management, Geography, Territorial Analysis and Sustainability, Architecture, Law, Social Work and Labour Relations and Employment and Master's Degree in General Health Psychology. - A B2 level of Spanish is mandatory to attend the Bachelor's Degrees of Hispanic Language and Literature, Publicity and Public Relations, Journalism, Audiovisual Communication, Physiotherapy, Medicine and Nursing. An official certificate of B2 level of Spanish is mandatory to attend the Master's Degree in Strategic Communication. - A B2 level of English is mandatory to attend all the Master's Degrees taught in English. - A B2 official certificate of English is mandatory to attend the Bachelor's Degree of English. - A C1 official certificate of English or a personal evaluation by the coordinator is mandatory to attend higher courses of the Bachelor's Degree of English and the Master's Degree in Professional English-Spanish Translation/ Teaching and Learning English as a Foreign and Second Language. - A C1 official certificate of Spanish is mandatory to attend the Master's Degree in Teaching Languages: Spanish as a Foreign Language, Professional English-Spanish Translation and General Health Psychology.

<p>Academic Requirements</p>	<p>Students will have to choose, at least, 50% of the credits from the field of study under which they have been nominated and, therefore, agreed upon in the bilateral agreement.</p> <p>Students can make their Bachelor's/Master's final project at the URV, <u>except in the fields of:</u> Law, Labour Relations, Nursing, Medicine, Physiotherapy, Physiotherapy (EUSES), Physical Activity and Sport Science (EUSES), Nutrition and Dietetics, Audiovisual Communication, Journalism, Publicity and Public Relations, Economics, Business Administration and Management, Geography, Territorial Analysis and Sustainability, Social Work, Tourism, English and Architecture.</p> <p>Training placements in any field of studies upon request.</p>
<p>Registration</p>	<p>Once the student have been selected to do a mobility period at the URV, exchange students must complete an online application and attach the required documents.</p> <p>At their arrival, the students must attend a welcome session, visit their academic coordinator and enrol the subjects of their learning agreement in the secretary.</p>
