



The Grand Duchy of Luxembourg




The Grand Duchy of Luxembourg is a small country in Western Europe bordered by Belgium, France and Germany. Luxembourg is a representative democracy in the form of a constitutional monarchy, with Grand Duke Henri the current head of state. The country is the only sovereign grand duchy in the world.

Around 47% of the country's 614,000 inhabitants are non-nationals, with people from more than 170 countries. Luxembourg covers an area of 2,586 square kilometres (998 square miles). It is a founding member of NATO and the European Union, home to numerous European institutions and a leading international financial centre as well as a strong, open and innovative economy.

Luxembourg is a trilingual country, with Luxembourgish, French and German as official languages. Most people also speak English but many more languages are routinely spoken in this cultural melting-pot.


