## **Nomination and Application Process**

- 1: The home institution will nominate students to HKR in accordance with the mutually agreed number of exchange places.
- 2: HKR sends link & instruction to in-coming students to apply.
- 3: Incoming student creates account on "Mobility-Online" to begin online application.
- 4: Students upload passport photo.
- 5: Students choose courses and print the application form.
- 6: Students upload the signed application form and transcript of record.
- 7: Students print the signed admission letter.
- 8: Students fill in online accommodation application form.
- 9: Students fill in arrival time.

Supporting Documents for Visa application	copies of the pages in your passport which show your personal details, the period of validity and whether you have

permission to live in countries other than your country of origin
<ul> <li>admission decision or letter of acceptance showing that you have been admitted to study a program or courses full-time</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>the decision on admission as a doctoral student with information about the time of admission (if you are a doctoral student)</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>copy of document proving that you have comprehensive medical insurance coverage in Sweden (if you have been admitted to studies that last less than one year). If you are insured through the university or university college, enclose a certificate to prove this</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>bank statement showing that you have the means to support yourself. This bank statement, which you are to enclose to your application, should be dated in connection with the time of application and be translated into English or</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>documents issued in your name, showing that you have received a scholarship or similar (e.g. student aid), including information about the monthly amount and the period during which you will receive such funds or</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>documents proving that you have been awarded an educational grant (only applies to doctoral students) or have been employed as a doctoral student, with information regarding the amount and the period during which you will receive such funds.</li> </ul>

One house is 68 m² and shared by four students: 2 single rooms (7m²) and 1 double room (12m²).  Fängelse Located in downtown Kristianstad, 10 minutes by bike from campus. There are 3 floors. Each floor has 3 corridors. Each corridor has 12 rooms. The room size varies from 6 m² to 13 m².
