

## DU Anglais des Affaires – Business English

### ORGANISATION

The fifteen-hour course runs from Monday 28<sup>th</sup> August to Friday 1<sup>st</sup> September, from 9.30 to 12.30pm and is given by experienced teachers of MOMA.

### AIMS OF THE COURSE

During this pre-teaching week, the course will mainly focus on **speaking** and **listening** skills through various activities like listening to videos, role plays and discussions in English ALL THE TIME. All the topics are related to business and management studies.

You will also have some homework to do for the following day. The videos are based on the majors taught at MOMA. Vocabulary exercises will help you enrich your knowledge of business expressions and reinforce your knowledge of phrasal verbs. The reading activities bring additional data and ideas that will be discussed /debated in groups. Although, no grammar exercises are included as such, the teacher will give guidance so as to help you remedy any typical mistakes.

Over the week you will have to prepare a presentation for Friday on a given theme. Your English teacher will go through the handout and instructions on Monday, will explain everything and answer any questions you may have.

### ASSESSMENT

Your final grade is based on three components:

1. (30%) is linked to your participation, efforts made and performance in both homework and classroom activities.
2. (30%) is based on Friday's listening test.
3. (40%) on Friday's oral presentation.

A University Certificate will be awarded on successful completion of the course.
