INITIAL TRAINING

The Licence 3 International Management program is unique and innovative, offering a curriculum that is highly sought-after by companies, and entirely in English. It's an opportunity for those who don't want to specialize in one subject and are motivated by an international dimension. The academic year is broken down as follows:

1st Semester: Fundamentals of Management Sciences (Management, Accounting and Financial Control, Marketing, Human Resources, Finance, Law...)
- enables students to apply for the Master's degree of their choice.

2nd Semester: Study abroad for one semester (see partner universities on the website). Courses selection: Marketing Sales, Accounting Finance, Management Strategy, Entrepreneurship or Hospitality and Tourism.

Note: for the 2nd semester, you can choose an original course to stand out from the crowd when applying for a Master's degree.

Objectives

Students graduating from the L3 IM program demonstrate an international outlook and adaptability that are highly valued by employers. With this in mind, we offer a Management degree accredited by the MESR with :

- a team of teachers and teachers researchers, with courses in English.
- a limited number of students to encourage pedagogical interaction.
- a class made up of international students (10 to 20 Erasmus students)
- six months abroad at one of our partner universities in over 20 countries.

Application process

- Applicants not from Montpellier Management:
PRE-SELECTION on the basis of a file including : APPLICATION completed on E-CANDIDAT and the results of a recent TOEIC or TOEFL test (less than one year old and level B2 minimum); (IAE Score optional)
SELECTION by interview;
CHOICE OF DESTINATION: following the interview, the successful candidate will be asked to submit 3 destination proposals for semester 6.
- Foreign students from outside the European Union must first submit an application to Campus France.
- Students who have completed the L2 Gestion at Montpellier Management can apply for the L3 IM: please follow the conditions and deadlines stipulated on our website.
