<b>Academic Calendar</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Semester 1: Classes: MARCH - end of JUNE Final Exams: JULY</li> <li>● Semester 2: Classes: AUGUST - end of DECEMBER Final Exams: DECEMBER</li> </ul>
<b>Languages</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● All classes are taught in SPANISH</li> <li>● Level required B2 or more</li> <li>● Language proof certificate is not required. However, students will not be able to follow and complete courses if their level of Spanish is lower than expected.</li> </ul>
<b>Nomination</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Coordinator must send an email to <a href="mailto:intercambio@palermo.edu">intercambio@palermo.edu</a> including name of the student, email address, and major at his/her university.</li> <li>● For semester 1: September 1 to October 15</li> <li>● For semester 2: March 1 to April 15</li> </ul>
<b>Application</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Students will receive an email with the application form and instructions to apply. Deadlines to submit applications:</li> <li>● For semester 1: September 15 to November 1</li> <li>● For semester 2: March 15 to May 1</li> </ul>
<b>Acceptance Letter</b>	Students will receive an acceptance letter the following week after deadline of submission of applications.

<b>MBA Courses</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Our MBA courses is open only to Advances Business students.</li> <li>● During application process, our MBA coordinator will decide if candidates can take courses at this level.</li> <li>● <a href="https://www.palermo.edu/negocios/mba/">https://www.palermo.edu/negocios/mba/</a></li> </ul>

<b>Health Insurance</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Health Insurance is mandatory.</li> <li>● The student is free to obtain the insurance he/she desires.</li> <li>● It is mandatory to buy a health insurance which covers evacuation &amp; repatriation.</li> </ul>
<b>Spanish Classes</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● We offer Spanish courses free of charge at ADVANCED level (B2/C1).</li> <li>● 3-hour weekly classes.</li> <li>● The Spanish course awards 4(four) credits.</li> </ul>
<b>Credits</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Students can take up to 5 (five) course per semester.</li> <li>● Courses award 4 (four) credits each.</li> <li>● One credit is one weekly hour of class attendance plus around two hours of study and homework per week, during the semester (minimum 17 weeks) including final exams.</li> <li>● The way credits are transferred to your university is their decision.</li> <li>● Exchange students can choose from all the available offer of courses, with the exception of thesis preparation, “pasantías” and Programa Ejecutivo.</li> </ul>
<b>Grading System</b>	<p>2 (two) FAILED LESS THAN 59%</p> <p>4 (four) PASSED GOOD 60% - 65%</p> <p>5 (five) PASSED GOOD + 66% - 71%</p> <p>6 (six) PASSED VERY GOOD - 72% -77%</p> <p>7 (seven) PASSED VERY GOOD 78% - 83%</p> <p>8 (eight) PASSED VERY GOOD + 84% - 89%</p> <p>9 (nine) PASSED EXCELLENT - 90% - 95%</p> <p>10 (ten) PASSED EXCELLENT 96% - 100%</p>
