## Apply!

To be part of our exchange program, you have to visit the international office of your university and apply. Once you have gathered your documents, your university will nominate you to **UNIVA** through the following link:

To be nominated, the following documents have to be included in your application and be sent to us:

- International Exchange Application (choose the **UNIVA** Campus);
- Accommodation Application (optional);
- Academic transcript (with the courses taken and about to take in your university);
- If your first language is not Spanish and you plan to take courses in this language, a Spanish language certificate, with a minimum level of B1;
- Motivation letter;
- Copy of passport;
- Nomination letter from your home university;
- International health insurance;

### Nomination deadlines

As **UNIVA** works with 3 academic periods per year, we can host students in the following periods, bearing in mind the nomination deadlines to apply:

#### Academic period

**Spring** (January - April)

**Summer** (May – August)

**Fall** (September - December)

#### Nomination deadline

**October 31** (previous year)

**February 28**

**June 30**

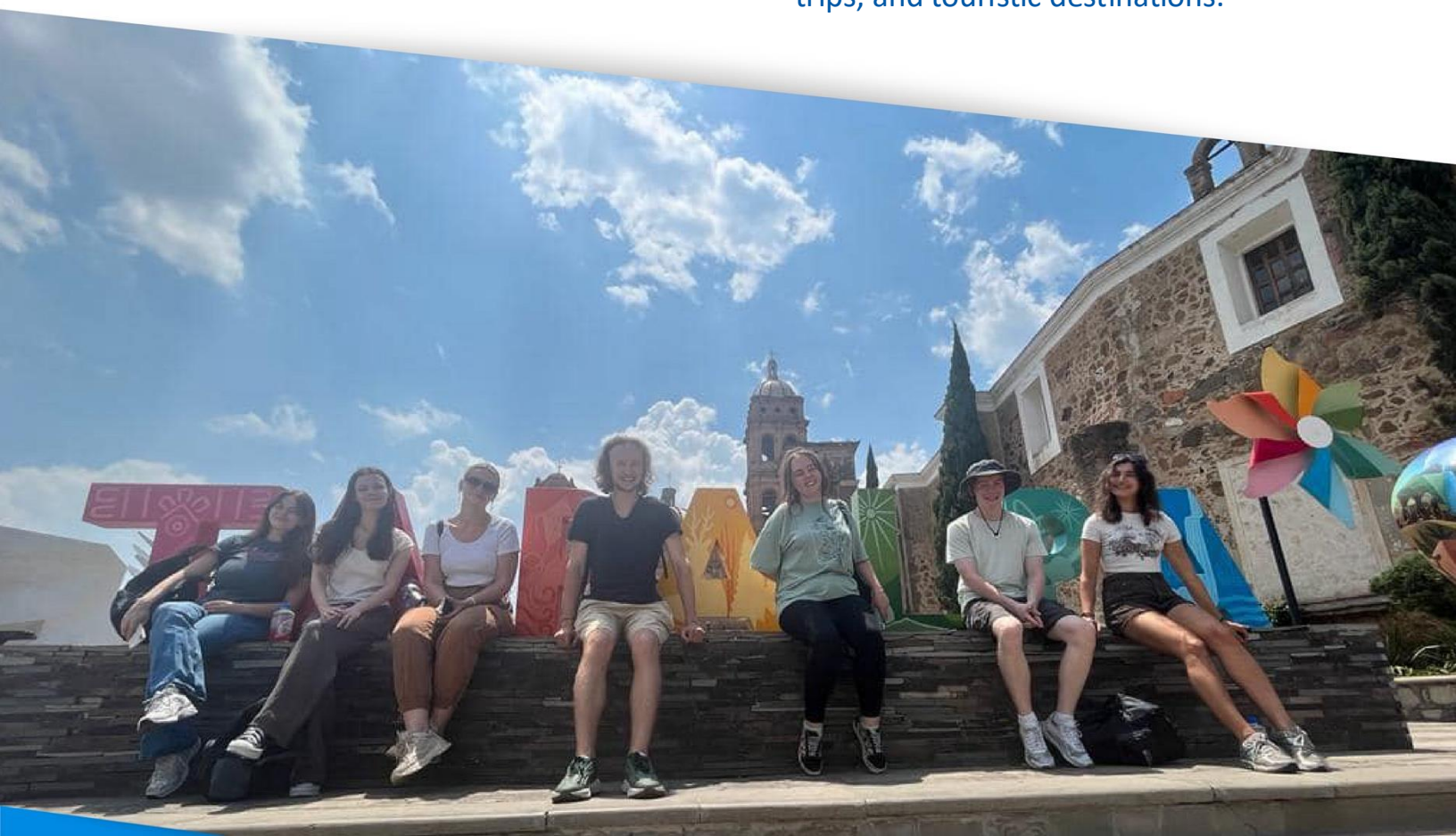
### Welcoming session

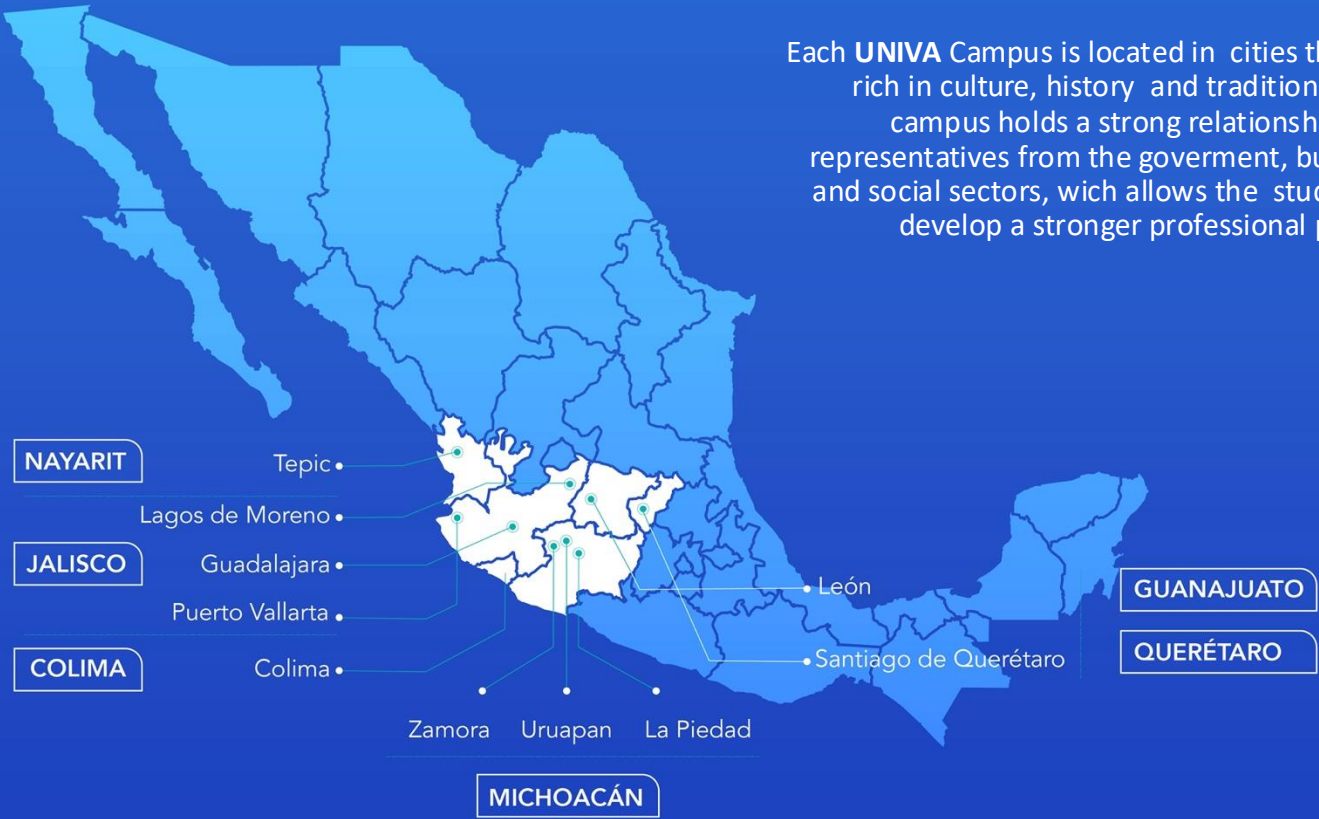
With their mentorship, exchange students receive orientation about, local transportation, Campus services, accommodation, living expenses, cultural trips, and touristic destinations.



# UNIVA Campus System

UNIVA has 11 Campuses in Mexico. A student can participate in an Exchange program for two periods, either in the same or different Campus:

- Jalisco: Guadalajara, Lagos de Moreno, Puerto Vallarta.
- Michoacán: La Piedad, Zamora, Uruapan.
- Querétaro: Santiago de Querétaro.
- Guanajuato: León
- Colima: Colima.
- Nayarit: Tepic.
