| Accommodation

i. UEH Dormitory

Exchange students can live in [UEH dormitories](#) for about \$60/month for a shared room (6 – 9 bunk beds). The dormitories have fully equipped facilities, such as self-study rooms, common rooms, elevators, laundry/drying rooms, drinking water systems, hot water, and wi-fi 24/7. To ensure security and order, the Dormitory has a 24-hour camera system on all floors and public areas, 24/24 security, and a security card swiping system at the entrance.

(The dormitory is very limited so a place is normally not guaranteed)

ii. Private apartment

\$500-\$1500/month with wi-fi, air-conditioner, private bathroom, kitchen, and living room. You can find it on [Rent Apartment](#), [Airbnb](#), [My Saigon City](#).

ii. Private room in a shared house/guest house

\$200-\$500/month with Wi-Fi, air-conditioner, shared/private bathroom, shared kitchen, and living room. You can find it at [Terranova](#).

Exchange students will be supported in finding their accommodation before arrival, either by maps or detailed descriptions of how to find it.

| Visa Application Procedure

After the complete submission of the application checklist, students will receive a Visa Approval Letter from ISB which allows them to officially apply for a student visa at Vietnam's Embassy/Consulate in their home country.

| Fees and Costs

1. Tuition and fees

All courses are waived for Exchange Students.

2. Health Insurance

Students are required to have adequate health insurance before coming to Vietnam.

3. Cost of Living

Approximately a minimum of 600 USD/month for living costs in Ho Chi Minh City, including accommodation, meals, textbooks, materials, student activities, and personal expenses.
