Visas	 Students studying for less than six months (one semester) will receive a Standard Visitor visa: Non-visa nationals receive a passport stamp at the UK Border. Visa-nationals must apply before entering the UK. Students studying for more than six months or from specific countries will need to apply for a Student visa.

Housing	 We have two recommended accommodation locations with our partner, AES, features our award-winning student support system including Resident Assistants (RAs) and Resident Directors (RDs). The Residence Life team, who are student staff living in the same accommodation, know the University and London well so are excellent resources in the first weeks of term. Brand-new apartments at AES Tower Hill offer unrivalled accommodation for students, with amazing views over London's iconic landmarks, such as Tower Bridge and the

	Tower of London. AES North End Road apartments offer up an ideal location within the midst of West Kensington, with Kensington Underground directly opposite the building.
Course Registration	 We will send out a login for our online self-service registration, along with instructions on how to register, as soon as we receive payment (if applicable) The academic advisors (Chiara, Camille or Maggie) will check the necessary pre-requisites and approve course choices. The advisors are happy to discuss course choices with students ahead of arrival over Teams.
